Ardoch Youth Foundation develops and coordinates projects that ensure all children and young people have everything they need to access, participate and achieve in education. The projects bring the community together to support the education of all young people, and aim particularly to assist children who are experiencing or are at risk of experiencing disadvantage.

Your Community group could help us by sponsoring one of the following:

- Swimming lessons for students who would otherwise miss out - \$80.00 per child.
- Attendance at school camp for students who would otherwise miss out - \$250.00 per child.
- Necessary school expenses such as text books, scientific calculators, art equipment etc.
- MET travel ticket to enable a student to get to and from school - \$310.00 per per child for 6 months.
- Support of individual families through a crisis eg housing, dental and medical costs.
- A breakfast club in one of our schools for a year - \$10,000 per year.
